Crochet Pattern

Mini Colourful Stockings

Crocheted with 4ply cotton with 6 US/3.5 mm crochet, these stockings are the perfect decoration for Christmas! You can make them to hang individually in the tree, in a garland to decorate a fireplace, or as a personal gift for someone you like! (I recommend filling them with candies beforehand to double the surprise). If you want to crochet this pattern with other type of yarn, just adapt the crochet size to the yarn, the info is usually in the label!

Abbreviations:

aum: do two sc in one stitch (augmentation)

ch: chain

C1: colour 1

C2: colour 2

Sc: single crochet

sc3tog: single crochet three together

sl: slip stitch

(x): number of stitches that you should have at the end of the row

Toecap (in C1)

Row 1: in a magic ring, do 5 sc (5)

Row 2: 5 aum (10)

Row 3: (1 sc – 1 aum) 5 times (15)

Row 4: (2 sc – 1 aum) 5 times (20)

Row 5: (3 sc – 1 aum) 5 times (25)

Row 6: 25 sc (25)

Main sock part 1 (in C2)


Row 7 – 12: 25 sc (25)

Row 13: 6 sc, then make 13 ch and skip the next 13 sc, do the last 6 sc of the row (25)

Row 14: 6 sc, 13 sc in the top part of the chain, 6 sc (25)

Heel (in C1)

These rows are crocheted in round between the two openings made by the ch. Join your C1 in the 7th stitch of the bottom part of the opening. That will be your starting point for each of the following rows. Here is a graphic explanation of the first row that hopefully will be useful:



Row 1: 6 sc, sc3tog (grabbing the last st of the bottom part, the opening between the two parts and the first st of the top part), 11 sc, sc3tog, sc to marker (24)

Row 2: sc until one before the corner, s3tog, sc until one before the corner, s3tog, sc to marker (20)

Row 3: sc until one before the corner, s3tog, sc until one before the corner, s3tog, sc to marker (16)

Row 4: sc until one before the corner, s3tog, sc until one before the corner, s3tog, sc to marker (12)

Main sock part 2 (in C2)

Row 15-23: 25 sc (25)

Border (in C1)

Row 24-27: 25 sc (25)

Close your finished stocking (hurray!) with 1 sl stitch into the first stitch of the previous row.

For hanging it you can do a 10 ch in the 13 st with a colour of your preference or sew a little ribbon to it. You are also free to decorate it as you want, with bells, embroidery or whatever you want! If, for example, you wanted to do a striped stocking (three colours instead of one) you just have to intercalate C2 and C3 each pair of rows in the main sections of the sock.
